Age limit

If you decide to join the European Solidarity Corps, remember that you can register from the age of 17, but you can't start a project until you are 18.

Participation is open to age 30 (35 for Humanitarian Aid Volunteering).

Requirements

Firstly, by joining, you commit to upholding the [European Solidarity Corps principles](#).

Then you should know that:

- you can only ever take part in **1 long-term volunteering activity** (2–12 months), but you can still do **team volunteering activities** and take part in **Solidarity Projects**
- if you take part in a **short-term** individual volunteering activity (up to 2 months), you can still:
 - take part in 1 long-term activity
 - do **team volunteering activities** and take part in **Solidarity Projects**

How does it work?

After registering in the European Solidarity Corps portal, you'll have access to a personal dashboard, where you'll find published opportunities to volunteer, work, train and more.

Also, if you've tagged yourself as available, you might be contacted by organizations that want to match you with their projects.

If you wish to take part in Humanitarian Aid Volunteering, you will need to take a self-assessment test and follow a specific training (online and face-to-face) in order to join the pool of candidate volunteers.

They collaborate with local employees and volunteers in the two job training programs promoted by Villa Javier, aimed at people in situations of poverty or social exclusion, the majority of whom are immigrants. - Organic AGRICULTURE: participation in practical training tasks and help in coordination of people and learning teams: growing vegetables in small gardens to supply the users of Villa Javier and sell in the local market. - Healthy traditional COOKING: participation in practical training tasks and help in the coordination of people and teams learning preparation and cooking of dishes to supply to the soup kitchen and sell in the local market. The role of ESC young people is to reinforce and enrich with their experience and initiatives the work of people in the process of learning and social inclusion, preparing them so that they can access ordinary employment.

ACCOMMODATION, FOOD AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

We provide ESC young people with initial accommodation in a shared apartment, although they can later choose other accommodation if they are interested. We give them money monthly to pay for room and board. In addition to pocket money. They will have a person who will act as a tutor, offering them personal support (bank account, health care, knowledge of the city...). The days off and vacations are those that correspond according to the program, according to your calendar. Tudela is a small city and it is not necessary to use urban transport, and we can provide you with a bicycle.
